1 Resolution 6-04 TO COMMEND THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH FOR ITS STANCE ON RELIGIOUS FREEDOMS AND DEFENSE OF THE RIGHTS OF THE 2 **UNBORN** 3 4 WHEREAS, God created human beings male and female as reflections of His own image (Gen. 5 1:27); and 6 7 WHEREAS, God's Word teaches that human life begins at conception (Psalm 139:13-16); and 8 9 WHEREAS, Through baptism into Christ Jesus we are reborn to eternal life as members of His 10 body, the Holy Christian Church (Romans 6:4); and 11 12 WHEREAS. As citizens of the United States of America, the First Amendment of the 13 Constitution guarantees the free exercise of our religious liberties; and 14 15 WHEREAS, The United States Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) has mandated that religious institutions, with only a narrow religious exception, must provide access to certain 16 contraceptive benefits (including contraceptives that can function as abortifacients), even if the 17 18 covered medications or procedures are contradictory to their beliefs; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Both The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod and The Roman Catholic Church have 21 publicly expressed their opposition to the mandates of the HHS concerning these contraceptive 22 benefits, including the latter's willingness to help defend this common religious right in civil 23 court; and 24 25 WHEREAS, The Lutheran Church--Missouri Synod stands with The Roman Catholic Church as 26 Christian citizens in this struggle and is proud and honored to do so; therefore be it 27 RESOLVED, That the South Wisconsin District in Convention publicly express its gratitude to the Roman Catholic Church for defending religious freedoms and the rights of the unborn; and 28 29 be it further 30 RESOLVED, That the South Wisconsin District invite the Archbishop of Milwaukee or his 31 representative to its 53rd convention to receive thanks for standing with The Lutheran Church-32 33 Missouri Synod on these issues of religious freedoms and human rights; and be it finally 34 35 RESOLVED, That the South Wisconsin District continue to pray for the preservation of both the 36 religious freedoms we enjoy as American citizens and the sanctity of human life as a gift of God. 37
