

## SWD Missions Weekly Prayer Calendar: July-August-September, 2016

*“Confessing Christ for the next generation” – this is what we do when we share the truth of the Gospel with others, and also when we pray! We invite you to partner with us in prayer as we bring these petitions to our Heavenly Father.*

**Week of July 3** – As our nation celebrates the **freedom we so often take for granted**, give all praise and thanks to our heavenly Father for His abundant blessings upon our country, in spite of our sins, and pray for guidance to those in authority to preserve peace in our land, and the freedom to worship Him without fear of persecution.

**Week of July 10** – As our **Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod** is holding their national convention in Milwaukee this week, pray fervently for our synod’s leaders, delegates, guests and volunteers as they work together in our common faith to promote the Good News of salvation to a world in dire need of His mercy, witness and life together.

**Week of July 17** – Pray for **Milwaukee’s SOS ministry** this week as they partner with District congregations this month with VBS programs for the children of the inner city neighborhoods. Please ask for the Holy Spirit’s work in the hearts of these children and their families as they often struggle for survival, needing the gospel’s saving message of eternal peace through Jesus Christ.

**Week of July 24** – As you pray this week, please remember our District’s **Hmong ministry** in Milwaukee, Manitowoc and Oshkosh. **Week of July 31** – Please pray this week for **Pastor Bud Palmer and Pastor John Reinke** who serve a vital ministry in our District among our **deaf communities and their families**. People who cope with a severe loss of hearing need our love, prayers and assistance in hearing and sharing the message of salvation.

**Week of August 7** – Please pray for the **Karenni ministry** among the Burmese refugees who have settled in the Milwaukee area and who meet on Sunday afternoons for worship, ESL, Sunday school and Adult instruction at Chapel of the Cross Lutheran Church, Milwaukee. More than 30 students are attending Trinity-Freistadt’s elementary school, and a growing number of high school students attend Milwaukee Lutheran High School. Boldly ask God to graciously open their hearts to the Gospel and raise up spiritual leaders from their own midst.

**Week of August 14** – In your prayers this week, please include **Rev. Elijah Ndon** (Holy Ghost Lutheran Church), **Rev. Dennis Harmon** (Hope Lutheran Church) and **Rev. Christian Ikanih**, (Bethany Lutheran Church) as they and other **Milwaukee urban congregations** struggle with difficult times that test their faith. Pray that they find their hope in the Lord and His goodness as they bring the saving message of God’s everlasting peace to these neighborhoods.

**Week of August 21** – Please pray this week for our **Campus Student and International Student ministries** within our UW system. Ask our Lord to work mightily through the friendship and hospitality that is offered to students away from home and country on these campuses in our District.

**Week of August 28** – As the school year begins once again, please ask our Lord to bless our teachers, students and parents of our **LCMS grade schools, high schools and university**.
