

## **South Wisconsin District Financial Aid Guidelines**

## Who may apply for financial assistance?

Members of congregations of the South Wisconsin District of The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod preparing for full-time\* church work in the LCMS are eligible to receive financial assistance from the South Wisconsin District.

\* Full-time service is defined as any position available through the Board of Assignments of the Synod.

## How to apply for financial assistance:

- 1. Complete the <u>SWD Financial Aid Application for Church Workers</u>.
- 2. Complete the <u>District Financial Aid Application</u> and give it to your college/seminary and request that pertinent information be forwarded to the South Wisconsin District at:

3. It is each student's responsibility to see that all forms are completed and returned by the **May 15 deadline**. Students should doublecheck with pastors and financial aid officers to see that all forms are returned in time. The District will inform you concerning the financial assistance action taken.

## Financial assistance expectations:

- 1. Applicants for District financial assistance should first request assistance from their home congregations.
- 2. Financial aid requests must be submitted each year to the District.
- 3. The amount of assistance will be determined based on the number of applicants, information received, and current resources available.
- 4. Monies granted for financial assistance will be forwarded to the school where the student is enrolled, to be applied to the student's account.
- 5. A student receiving financial aid is expected to lead a Christian life and to be faithful in their studies.
- 6. All students receiving financial assistance are expected to complete a minimum of two (2) years of full-time service in the church upon graduation (as assigned though the Synod's placement committee and the normal call process).
