Floor nominations must be made by a delegate of the region served by the vice president. Write-in candidates are not permitted on the convention ballot. Written consent and biographical materials shall be presented to the Secretary at or before the time of nomination.

A congregation may choose to submit one, two, or no names for the office of Vice-President of their region. He must be a member of a member congregation of the same region by the time of the election.
